

The questions most frequently asked by our guests ...

• How far is it to the ski lift station?

The ski lift is only a stone's throw away ... because Das Hohe Salve Sportresort is located right next to the Hohe Salve cable car. This takes you directly up to the entrance to the ski resort at SkiWelt Wilder Kaiser-Brixental.

- Is there a supermarket nearby? The nearest supermarket is in the centre of Hopfgarten ... around 200 m from the hotel.
- Is there a pharmacy in the village? Yes, we also have a pharmacy in the village. You can reach the local Brixental pharmacy in a few minutes from the hotel.
- Are towels provided in the Move & Relax area? Yes, you can help yourself to towels in the Move & Relax area. In order to help the environment, we ask that you only take as many towels as you actually need ... THANKS!
- Where can you go for a nice walk from the hotel? The network of official walking routes in the Kitzbühel Alps region stretches to around 2,500 kilometres. Whatever you are looking for and whatever your fitness, there are marked routes for everyone, going up to 2,400 meters high.
- Is use of the Move & Relax area included in the price?
 Yes entry to our 1,400 m² Move & Relax area is included in the price. Please note that there is an extra charge for individual treatments and the daily training programme.
- Do you have room service or is there a minibar in the room? I'm afraid we'll have to disappoint you there as we have neither. Why? Well, because our hotel bar is open for you from 16:00 until 01:00 ... and it's so cosy in there.
- Is there a discount for the Alpin and Intersport ski schools?
 Only our partner Intersport Oberhauser offers a discount for our guests 15% off ski equipment when booked online.

• Where do I find the bus stop for the free ski shuttle to Westendorf etc.? The nearest bus stop is right by the train station in Hopfgarten, opposite our hotel – only 5 minutes on foot.

• Can I add my hotel restaurant/bar bill to the bill for my room?

Of course – we would be happy to add it to the bill for your room and you can conveniently pay for everything at the same time when you check out.

• Poor weather programme

You won't get bored even if the weather is bad ... because we have a few indoor activities for you too. There are also lots of attractions in the region that you can visit during bad weather. You can find information about these at our reception.

• Are there options for going out, such as bars etc.?

You can find the right venue for every night owl here in the area, whether you are looking for après ski during your winter holiday, ice-cold drinks on a hot summer evening, or a cosy evening with friends.
